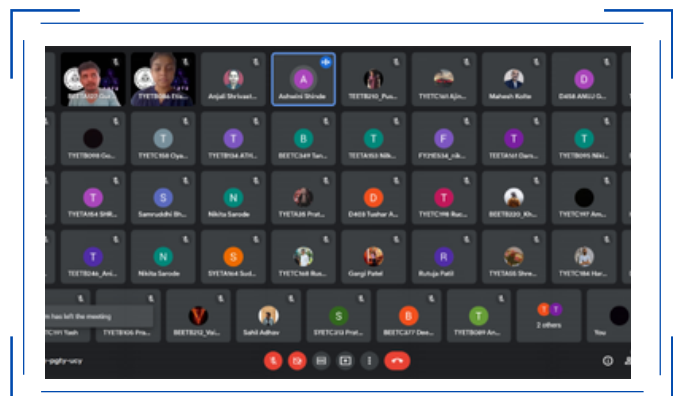
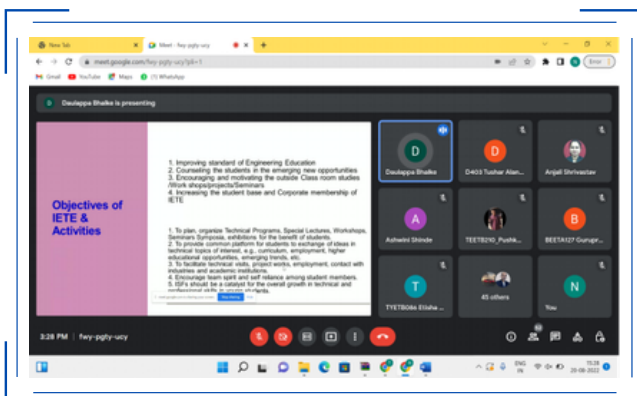
IETE Membership Drive & ETSA Induction Program

13th Oct 2022 and 14th Oct 2022

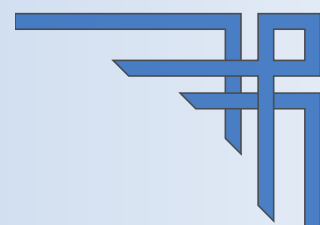

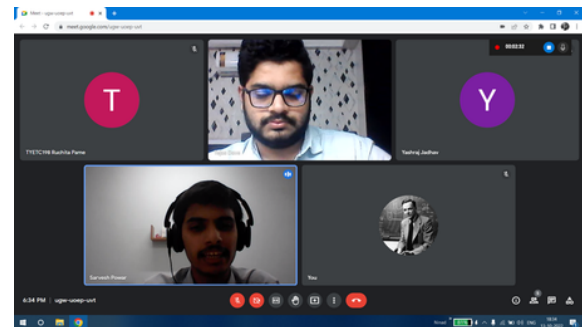
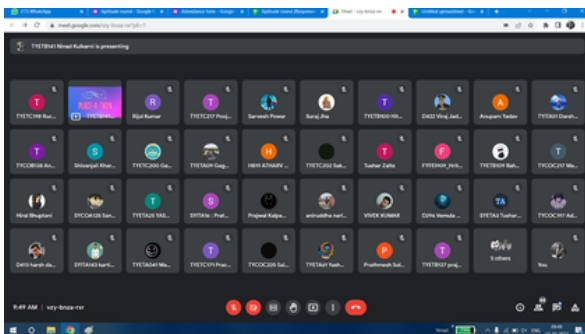
Place-a-thon

14th October 2022

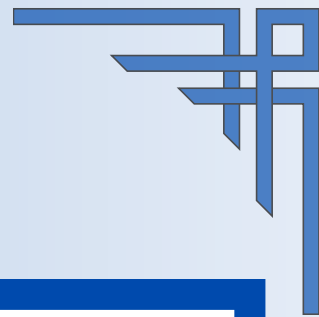

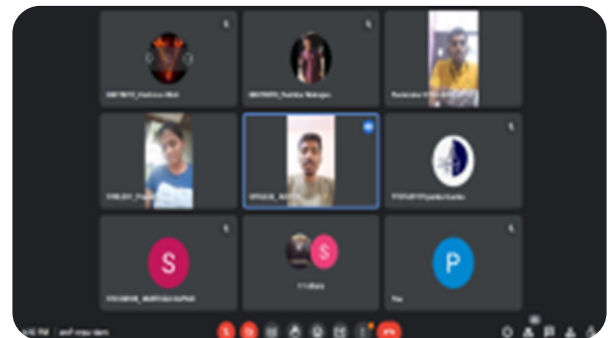
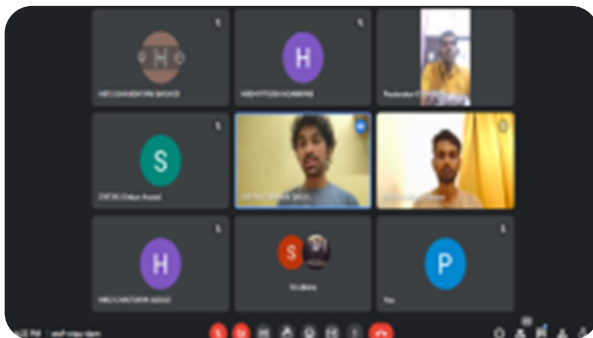


Posterator

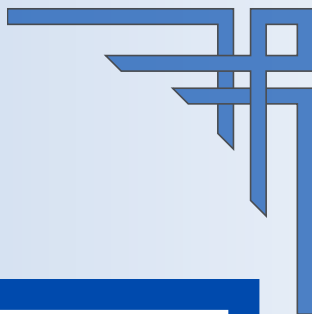


Day 1 of the Event: Paper Presentation.

Day2 of Event: Valedictory Function

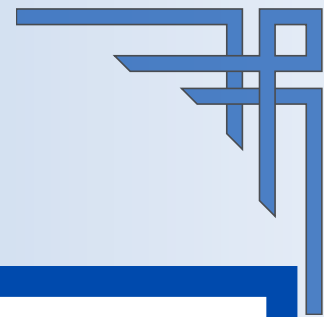

Inauguration Ceremony

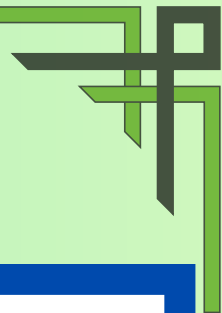
